- Keep students safe while timing and monitoring seizures
- Respond confidently and competently to seizures in the school setting

SRFA is a pre requisite for Diastat Training and we successfully collaborate with districts by providing all materials required for Diastat training, enabling compliance with CA ED Code 49414.7. We also provide an epilepsy specific resource packet for your school nurse.

We realize seizures at school can be very stressful for your staff. By scheduling a SRFA presentation at your site, you will; reduce staff anxiety, instill staff confidence through proficiency, and most important, keep your students with epilepsy safe.
